1 OPENING

The chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting and asked the applicants if they were happy to speak about their applications in front of others. They agreed.

Chris Scrase declared an interest in the application from Tekapo Trails.

4 REPORTS

4.1 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING HELD TO CONSIDER GENESIS GRANTS

The minutes of the last meeting were noted. They were confirmed as accurate at an earlier meeting.

4.2 ALLOCATION OF GRANTS

The chairman gave applicants an opportunity to speak in support of their application.

Brooke Gardner from Tekapo Saturday Markets – Noted she was also looking for funding to hire the Tekapo Hall so the market can be moved there when it rains. Stallholders do not currently pay for stalls as she believes they do enough to get to Tekapo, including travelling long distances in some cases. The committee asked if stallholders would be asked to contribute in the future. She

said it was a wait-and-see situation. The community board said they would like to see some quotes to show how the money would be spent.

Simon Waymouth from Tekapo School/Paint the Town Green – Mr Waymouth showed a chart that outlined the initiatives that were included under Paint the Town Green. He was asking for money for signage and rubbish and recycling bins that would be used by the school. The community board noted that it would be important to have the same colour combination as the bins that were currently used in the town.

James Lazor from Mount Dobson Ski Field — The application was for weather recording equipment at the top of Mount Dobson. This would provide free weather information to the community, as well as to Mount Dobson staff.

TJ McConchie from Tekapo Trails – She said Tekapo Trails needed a website to provide maps and information about the town's trails. The application was for money to provide this. The quote to do both website and Facebook was \$3,000 but this had been trimmed down to hosting the website to save money. They were also asking for three loads of gravel to complete the track metalling. The Tekapo Trails website would be linked to other websites including council and tourism websites.

The chairperson informed applicants that the meeting would go into public excluded to discuss the merits of each application and a recommendation would go to full Council at its meeting on November 3. Following this the applicants would be informed of the outcome. He thanked them for attending and they left the room.
