 - Possum Dough to provide our loanees to get them started est. \$25 + freight
 - (2) Other traps for purchasing will include:
 - 5-10x each of DOC150/200/250 Mustelid traps priced between \$100-\$180 exclu. Each
 - (3) As well as tools for ease of use and maintenance tools:

Dear Twizel Community Board,

RE: Funding for the Twizel Trap Library

We are writing to you to request funding to enable the set-up of a trap library for Twizel. The trap library would allow Twizel Residents the opportunity to loan traps from the library.

The Ohau Conservation Trust has kindly loaned the library 20 x Trapinator traps, which are kill traps for possums; our project will need to purchase and supply a marine ply backing board to extend the life of the trap and so part of the funding will go towards purchasing a sheet of marine ply and screws as well as a bucket of possum dough (possum lure) of which a small amount will be provided with traps to get people started.

We would also like to purchase 10 x BT 200 Traps in wooden housing, these are valued at around \$87.49 excl GST each, and would allow trapping of stoats, ferrets, hedgehogs, rats.

These traps require a few equipment pieces optional to the loanee including a setting tool, valued at \$10 excl GST each, a Terra Don (carcass removing tool) \$11.50 excl GST, safety clip/s, a piece of hose and gloves. Ideally also a lure could be offered in the form of an egg or rabbit meat.

The funding would also likely be used to place an advert in the Twizel Update, printing of agreement/waiver forms (although we hope to be mostly paperless) and other expense costs incurred by volunteers administering the project.

We will operate the Trap Library under the Twizel Promotion's umbrella and they will administer the funding on our behalf, and therefore there is no balance sheet or financial statement included with our application.
